Mariam Noujaim is a member of SEIU Local 1000. SEIU Local 1000 held elections for Statewide Officers in May 2011. The elections were conducted by mail. The election instructions provided that:

<u>Use a black pen only, TO BE VALID,</u> your name must be <u>SIGNED</u> on the back of the attached return envelope in the designated location.

Ballots must be received at the election office, 1337 Howe Avenue, Ste. 250, Sacramento, CA. 95825 through the U.S. Postal Service by 5:00 P.M., Friday, May 20, 2011.

The ballots will be opened May 20, 2011 at 1321 Howe Avenue, Ste. 200, Sacramento, CA. 95825 beginning at 1:00 P.M., and observers are welcome.

Ballots will be counted on May 21-22, 2011 at 1321 Howe Avenue, Ste. 200, Sacramento, CA. 95825, beginning at 9:00 A.M. and observers are welcome.

The election protest period begins on May 31, 2011

Results of protest committee's findings will be mailed to all parties on June 25, 2011

On May 20, 2011, Noujaim went to 1321 Howe Avenue, Ste. 200, Sacramento, CA 95825 to observe the opening of the election ballots. While observing this she noted that a number of the envelopes that were being opened did not post marked by the U.S. Postal Service. Noujaim inquired about the fact that the ballots were not post marked. The election official did not deny the fact that a number of ballots being opened were not post marked. He told Noujaim to "go ask SEIU." A woman who was representing SEIU Local 1000 then ordered Noujaim to leave the observation area. She was then pushed out and the door locked. She was prohibited from observing the opening of the election ballots by SEIU Local 1000 representatives.

Noujaim filed an election protest on June 6, 2011. To date, SEIU Local 1000 has not responded to her protest despite the fact the protest results were to be mailed on June 25, 2011.

By prohibiting Noujaim from observing the SEIU Local 1000 ballot openings and failing to respond to her election protest, SEIU Local 1000 denied Noujaim her right as a union member to observe the opening of the election ballots and object to the procedures used thus depriving her and interfering with her rights under the Dills Act to participate in union activities. Noujaim requests that the election results be set aside because they were not obtained pursuant to the information provided to Noujaim and all SEIU Local 1000 members.
